This is another fund raiser for The Gallery and we hope that all artists will help to make this a success even if you are not a photographer. This is a smarter entry show - last day to submit your entries is September 4<sup>th</sup>. The Photography Show will be on display the month of October. Depending on number of entries we will only be able to accept limited non-show entries in The Gallery that month.

Linda Poteet is also hard at putting together Paint Lodi Event. She submitted a mini grant request to the Lodi Art Commission and it was granted so initially she has \$700 to fund the event. We are also looking for additional underwriting. If you know a

#### **August Show**

Our featured artist is Elsa Bates. Reception for the show is August 4<sup>th</sup>. Pickup for membership and receiving for the August show is July 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> between noon and 5PM on Saturday and noon and 4PM on Sunday. The new fee structure goes into effect for the August show. We will post the fee structure in the gallery. New gallery percentage is 30%. The \$5 hanging fee remains the same for hanging items. New fee structure for pottery, glass, jewelry is based on space used \$10 per 4ft shelf. \$10 for personal card racks, cards, prints and matted originals in general rack is \$5 unless you have paid for other items in The Gallery.

Provides content to our Newsletter Chairman and Web Master to include in our Newsletter and on our website.


